



Simon is co-founder of cybersecurity startup RunSafe Security. RunSafe was developed as part of DARPA's program of cybersecurity for DoD vehicles, drones, and medical devices. He also worked with Apple and Samsung in hardening their mobile devices for government use. He is a member of SAE's IoT Cybersecurity Committee and an author in their new book "Cybersecurity for Commercial Vehicles".
